OPERATIONS

In the Gaza strip where unemployment rate hits **90% (UNRWA, 2020)**, students and their families are unable to pay the tuition fees. In response to the ongoing need for financial support. The University provides various grants under its Needy student support initiative for students enrolled. Within this initiative, IUG works to support students faced with financial difficulties that may be affecting their studies

In 2021, **10,215** students have benefited from tuition fees scholarships provided by IUG. Furthermore, IUG has dedicated departments that conduct field study research to classify students based on their financial situation.
